Puerto Rican Indian Wars: Part II

One of New York's best know Taíno Native American story tellers and lecturers, Bobby González has written a collection of poems and short stories about the Native American experience from a Taíno perspective, Puerto Rican Indian Wars: Part II.

Published by Galería Cemí Press, the book features a variety of poems taken directly from myths, legends and traditions bequeathed to us by the Taíno Indians who inhabit the major Caribbean Islands of Puerto Rico, Dominican Republic/Haiti, Cuba, Jamaica and the Bahamas.
